## JUNIOR PLAYING PROGRAMS 2024

**RICHMOND COUNTRY CLUB** is committed to growing the game of Golf in our community. Our Junior playing programs are available to all children, ages 12-18 years, including children and relatives of our Adult Members, plus an additional thirty-five memberships for non-affiliated families.

As a Junior Program Member, there are no initiation fees, monthly dues or food and beverage minimum requirements. Junior Members pay an annual fee and earn restricted access to our practice facilities and 18-hole championship course via our education and testing programs.

Within the Junior Program Membership, there are two levels. Both levels have restricted course and booking access, based on individual skills and their commitment to learning and improving. Members may graduate between these levels with completion of advanced education seminars, on-course clinics, written and course testing.

Club Standards & Privileges Exam

- Confirming Members and guests understanding of on-course procedures, manners and course care minimum standards
- Required to earn unsupervised playing privileges

Basic Rules & Handicap Exam

- 20 questions on the basics - free relief, penalty situations and scoring for handicap purposes
- Required to participate in Advanced Junior Program events

Tournament & Unusual Exam

- 20 questions on advanced tournament Rules and situations
- Prerequisite for Junior Club Championship and for financial assistance
