Swimming Pool Rules

- 1. Pool area may be open from 9:00am to 9:00pm (weather permitting), mid-June through Labour Day weekend.
- 2. All persons using the swimming pool do so AT THEIR OWN RISK.
- 3. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- 4. Persons with open wounds, bandages or skin conditions are not permitted use of the pool or whirlpools.
- 5. Proper swim wear must be worn in the swimming pool. Thong bathing suits are not permitted. Infants should wear cloth diapers and plastic pants or specifically designed pool pants. Disposable diapers are not permitted. Pool diapers are available for purchase in the Racquet Centre.
- 6. Persons may not enter the pool wearing bobby pins, metal fasteners, or any other adornment that may in any way damage the filters, unless they are wearing a bathing cap.
- 7. Lounge chairs may not be reserved; Adult members have priority for use of lounge chairs.
- 8. Members must supply their own towel. Club locker room towels are not permitted in pool area. Pool towels are available in the Racquet Centre.
- 9. Guest Rules See General Rules No. 25, Page 10.
 - All guests must be registered at the Racquet Centre by completing a chit prior to entering the pool area (adults \$10, children \$5). There is no charge for members' children or grandchildren who are under age 12.
 - Members are allowed to bring the same guest twice per month, with a maximum of 2 guests per visit. Regular Pool guest rates would apply.
- 10. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times. Children under the age of seven must be accompanied by a responsible adult and be within arms reach of that adult when they are in the pool. Parents are requested to take direct care of their children while using the pool and are responsible for their conduct in this area.
- 11. Members and their guests must not run, splash or make nuisances of themselves or disturb the enjoyment of other members by the pool. Anyone violating this rule may be asked to leave
- 12. Inflatable toys are not permitted in the pool.
- 13. Only food and beverages purchased through the clubhouse may be brought to the pool area. No food from outside sources is permitted.
- 14. Members shall place all refuse in the proper recycling and garbage containers.
- 15. Cell Phone & Smoking Policies apply See page 7 for complete details.
- 16. Owing to the family nature of this area, smoking in the pool grounds or adjacent areas is prohibited.
