### **HOURS OF OPERATION**

During Active Season, the Golf Shop, Golf Course, and Practice Areas\* will open:

MONDAYS

9:30am

(Golf Course opens at 11:00am)

TUESDAY – FRIDAYS

7:00am

SAT/SUN/HOLIDAYS

6:00am

\*The Driving Range closes early on Wednesday and Sunday evenings, and opens late on Thursdays.

The Golf Shop will close approx. 90 minutes prior to dusk, but the Back Shop will remain open until dark, providing storage, power cart, and practice area services.



## **CELL PHONE POLICY**

This policy governs the use of cell phone and PDA devices ("Devices") on the golf course and adjacent lands.

Devices must be turned off or switched to silent or vibrate mode. Discreet, non-verbal (silent) communication (text messaging, email and voicemail retrieval) is permitted, but verbal cellular communication north of the ditch and at any practice area is prohibited.

Except in the case of an emergency, making or receiving cellular phone calls on the golf course is strongly discouraged. Time sensitive phone calls are, however, permitted on the golf course provided they are discreet, short in duration, and without exception do not hold up the pace of play or otherwise interfere with another person's play.

## **SMOKING POLICY**

Smoking and vaping (including cigars, e-cigarettes, and marijuana) are not permitted in the clubhouse or breezeway areas. This is in compliance of the City of Richmond's By-laws that prohibit smoking within a 6 metre setback of a doorway entrance to a building. Also, unless otherwise designated by management, smoking will not be permitted in the area south of the parking lot to the north portion of the ditch, in the pool area, tennis courts or golf driving range.

## **CARE OF THE GOLF COURSE**

In order to maintain the best possible playing conditions, all golfers are expected to observe the following:

- Use Sand & Seed Bottles provided to fill divots, except those on the tee boxes (replace large divots, please).
- Fix all ball marks on the greens.
- Smooth all bunkers after play, and replace the rakes provided with the handle resting on the edge of the bunker, with the head directed inwards.



- Keep pull carts and power carts behind the white lines, staying away from areas between greenside bunkers and the greens themselves.

To help ensure the best golf conditions for all, please help us take Care of the Course:



### **Repair Ball Marks**

Please fix your own mark plus at least one other

### **Fill Divots**

Please use the sand & seed mix provided



### **Rake Bunkers**

Please replace the head towards the centre and the handle against the edge



### **Keep Carts Behind White Lines**

Please keep pull and power carts at least 30 feet away from the green edges

## **DRESS CODE**

Richmond CC's Golf Dress Code Policy applies to: the entire golf course and all practice areas (Driving Range, Putting Green, and Short Game Areas). RCC's Golf Dress Code is reflective of members' tastes and styles as approved on a year-to-year basis by the Match Committee and Board of Directors. Members are reminded that they are also responsible for the dress of their guests.



## **Men and Boys:**

### PERMITTED:

- Polo shirts with a collar or mock/turtle neck shirts must be worn.
- Golf shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Conservative length golf shorts are permitted.
- Bermuda length shorts within 4 inches of the top of the knee.
- Hats shall be worn in the proper, bill-forward manner.

### NOT PERMITTED:

- Denim, camouflage, and cargo pants or shorts with expandable pockets.
- Shorts that extend beyond the knee.
- T-shirts, crew-neck and V-neck shirts and athletic style pants or short shorts.

## **Women and Girls:**

### PERMITTED:

- Sleeveless collared golf shirts or t-shirts must all be in good taste, and while certain tailored tops may be worn outside the pants, tops must cover the midriff at all times.
- Conservative length shorts, skirts, golf dresses, capri pants or golf skorts are all permitted.

### NOT PERMITTED:

- Tank tops, halter tops and short shorts. Athletic style, yoga pants or leggings or may be worn under skorts or shorts only.
- Denim, camouflage, and cargo pants or shorts with expandable pockets.

## **Shoes:**

Golf shoes with soft-spikes or spikeless rubber soles may be worn on the golf course and are permitted on the lower floor of the clubhouse. Golf shoes with soft-spikes are not permitted on the carpeted areas of the upper floor of the clubhouse; however cleaned golf shoes may be worn on the upper floor outside balcony only.

*Note: Management and Staff reserve the right to define "permitted" attire.*





## PACE OF PLAY POLICY

In order to accommodate golfers with varying preferences, the Golf Committee and Board of Directors have approved the following Pace of Play:

- Keep up to the group in front of you.
- Expected Front 9 Pace - 1 hour, 58 minutes
- Expected Back 9 Pace - 2 hours, 2 minutes = Expected 18 hole Pace - 4 hours
- Maximum Allowed Pace of Play is 4 hours and 15 minutes
- \*New: There are 6 clocks on the golf course to help groups monitor their own pace of play.

Failing to comply with the Pace of Play Policy, or failing to properly clock-in:

**1<sup>ST</sup> OFFENCE:** A letter of warning will be sent to the member(s) involved.

**2<sup>ND</sup> OFFENCE:** Possible restriction of playing privileges for a period of two weeks.





During Active Season (May 1 – Sep 30), every group is responsible for correctly clocking in with the Time Clock, regardless of the number of holes being played. The touch-screen Time Clock must be initiated when starting each round (under Starts tab, top left), after finishing the 9th hole (under Turns tab), and after finishing the 18th hole (under Finishes tab). Simply have anybody in the group touch “Now” beside the group’s tee time.

**GUESTS**

Members are responsible for ensuring that their guests adhere to the Club’s Standards. Local guests are permitted to play no more than one game per calendar month.
